Lafayette County Food Pantry

Particular needs are Hamburger Helper, personal care products (shampoo, conditioner, lotion, etc.), baby wipes, diapers (sizes 2, 3, & 5). Toilet paper and paper towels are always needed.

Non-perishable donations can be dropped off at Grace in the shopping cart located near the fellowship area. **Frozen** products can be dropped off at the Food Pantry on Tuesdays or Thursdays (10:00-3:00). Tell them you represent Grace Lutheran Church, and your donation will be added to our ongoing count of pounds for 2025! **May total was 25#. The total for 2025 is 305#.**

On the display outside the office there are envelopes containing the size and item needed per person so we can keep track of new items, but all donations are welcome.
