Kris Fleming Mission Moment Presenter at 2020 Grace Annual Meeting on the Lafayette County OWI Court (operating with an intoxicant) an alternative to incarcerating repeat offenders, will take about 10 people at a time.

The program would require them to maintain sobriety, come before the court on a weekly basis and go to weekly treatment and behavioral therapy.

They would also be subjected to random testing to make sure that they are staying sober.

The OWI court would have five phases and milestones that offenders have to complete, and would take about 18 months to finish.

Kris enriched us with her knowledge of this service and her supporting it for county citizens.
