Due to ongoing concerns with the Covid-19 Pandemic, We will restart our church services via parking lot services beginning on June 28. Please take note of the following:

- Church will begin at 9:00 AM in the parking lot of the church.
- We ask that all cars park at the bottom parking lot.
- Pastor Larry will be speaking via a microphone that transmits to an AM station on your car radio. You will be informed of the station number when you arrive.
- Pastor will be at a podium at the basement door entry or inside the church.
- Services will consist of a pastoral greeting, readings, the gospel, a sermon, and a blessing. There will not be communion or songs. If there are announcements, we will figure out how to get those in writing to Pastor ahead of time or during the service.
- Services will be approximately 30 to 40 minutes long.
- The offering can be dropped off with the parking attendant/usher as you enter or exit the parking lot.
- There will be a parking attendant to assist in parking in an efficient manner to make best use of the available parking space. We will try to have everyone back into their parking spot and face the basement door of the church.

A congregational meeting is scheduled on July 12, 2020 following the 9:00 AM services. This business meeting is to vote on calling the pastor candidate recommended by the call committee. The June 28 9:00 AM service is our First Notice of Congregational Meeting. The July 5th 9:00 AM service is the Second Notice of Congregational Meeting.

REOPENING CONT...

For services on Sunday, July 12 at 9:00 AM, we will:

- Have a short church service.
- Have a meet and greet with our call candidate. For now, we plan to do this via transmission to your car and/or social distancing in the parking lot. We may move it to the pool park shelter in the event of rain. More information will be available as circumstances develop.
- Following the meet and greet, we will have a short congregational business meeting to vote to call the candidate as the next Grace Lutheran Church pastor.




